WORD AND SONG

3x songs to sing together then split into 5x small groups to each respectively look at the Bible and a church song that expresses its theme either explicitly or implicitly.

5x Songs to study are:

- 1. Better is one day (Psalm 84)
- 2. **No Other Name** (Acts 4:1-22)
- 3. Your Grace is Enough (1 Cor. 1:18-31; 2 Cor. 12:6-10)
- 4. Here is Love (Eph. 3:12-21)
- 5. Let Your Kingdom Come (Matt. 6:9-15)

This simple small group questions are:

- How does this Bible passage relate to the song?
- How does the song expand on or illustrate the theme of the Bible passage?
- How does the song help you emotionally engage with the truth of the Bible?
- What ideas has the song left out that it could possibly have been included?
- What's your personal opinion of this song musically? Is it singable? Is it true?

Each group has 25 minutes to explore the Bible passage and the song and then make a brief 3-5 minute presentation before we all sing the song together.

Repeat the process for each group and song.
