

OUR SPECIAL GUEST SPEAKER, OS GUINNESS



Os Guinness is an author and social critic. The great-great-great grandson of Arthur Guinness, the Dublin brewer, Os was born in China in World War II, where his parents were medical missionaries. A witness to the climax of the Chinese revolution in 1949, he was expelled with many other foreigners in 1951, and returned to Europe where he was educated in England. He completed his undergraduate degree at the University of London and his D.Phil in the social sciences at Oriel College, Oxford.

Before moving to the United States in 1984, Os was a free-lance reporter with the BBC. Since then, he has been a Guest Scholar at the Woodrow Wilson Center for International Studies, a Guest Scholar and Visiting Fellow at the Brookings Institution, and Senior Fellow at the Trinity Forum and the East-West Institute in New York. He is currently a senior fellow at the Oxford Centre for Christian Apologetics in Oxford, though he still lives with his wife Jenny in the Washington, DC, area.

Os has written or edited more than thirty books, including *The Call, Time for Truth, Long Journey Home, Unspeakable, A Free People's Suicide, The Global Public Square*, and *Renaissance*. His latest book is *Fool's Talk: The Recovery of Christian Persuasion*, which was published by InterVarsity Press in June, 2015.
